CUB SCOUT Q&A



- **What is Cub Scouts?**

Cub Scouts is a program of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA), and is designed to promote learning, values, fun, and friendship in a caring and nurturing environment. The program was originally organized in 1930 and has grown to become the largest of the BSA's three membership divisions (Boy Scouts and Venturing being the other two).

- **How is the Cub Scout Program organized?**

All boys belong to the Pack (our Pack is 733). The Pack is divided into Dens, with each Den being grade-specific so that boys share experiences appropriate to their age and maturity. The Pack is led by the Cubmaster and the Dens are led by the Den Leaders. Committee members help to organize and manage the activities of the Pack. All leadership positions are voluntary.

- **Who can join Cub Scouts?**

Cub Scouting is open to all boys in grades 1-5. Boys can join at any time, regardless of whether they have participated during the earlier grades.

- **What do boys do in Cub Scouts?**

Together, the boys learn, explore, play, and have fun.

Camping

Hiking

Fishing

Sports

Earn awards, badges, patches

Crafts

Games

Visit police, fire, television, radio stations

Build and race model cars (Pinewood Derby)

Attend professional sporting events

- **How often to Cub Scouts meet?**

Dens meet 1-2 times per month and the Pack meets 1 time per month. There is usually 1 Pack activity per month that is separate from the Den and Pack meetings. The boys love learning and sharing experiences with their friends and family. Attendance is encouraged at each event, but is not mandatory.

- **When do Cub Scouts meet?**

Each Den will determine the day and time for Den meetings that best suits the families. Pack meetings are held at 6:00 PM the third Wednesday of each month at the Yorba Linda Community Center on Imperial Highway. Meetings typically last about 1 hour.

- **How much does it cost?**

Annual membership is \$22.00, which pays for registration with the BSA. Uniforms are approximately \$50 (you only need one). Events throughout the year are voluntary and usually cost between \$15-\$50 for each outing.
